- **Are you licensed?**
Medical aestheticians receive formal training in cosmetology from a state-approved aesthetics program.
- **How many hours of training have you had?**
Most states require that an aesthetician have a minimum of 300-600 hours of training.

- **Does this practice allow you to administer Botox and other dermal fillers?**
